She also writes natural history and environment books and magazine articles for adults. A past nominee for both the Red Cedar Book Award and Silver Birch Book Award, Elin's writing has been recognized by the Canadian Children's Book Centre, Ontario Library Association, and Canadian Science Writers' Association.

She holds a PhD in international environmental policy and science education from King's College London and teaches in the Environmental Education and Communications Program at Royal Roads University in Victoria, British Columbia. Elin also serves as a consultant for educational projects designed to engage the public in environmental initiatives. She has extensive experience in science learning in informal settings and has served in such a capacity at the Canadian Museum of Nature, Vancouver Aquarium, Calgary Zoo, and Monterey Bay Aquarium.

Elin lives with her husband, a marine-life expert, and their two children, splitting time between Bowen Island, British Columbia and Monterey, California.
